

1. Conditions for eligibility of candidates for studentship

The following conditions will be imposed on selecting candidates for studentship.

- Any student who has been officially punished by the University for any offenses committed, will not be considered eligible for the studentship.
- If a student commit any offense and punished officially by the university during his/ her period of studentship, his/ her studentship will be cancelled.
- A student cannot receive more than one studentship offered by Faculty of Engineering at the same time. In case if he/ she is eligible for more than one studentship he/ she shall be only given studentship with highest amount.
- The following combinations of financial condition and academic performance will be considered each year for selecting a student for studentship.

Year	Financial Condition (%)	Academic Performance (%)

2	75	25
3	50	50
4	25	75

It was decided to distribute the application form attached herewith, to collect necessary information of students for deciding eligible candidate.

2. Criteria for shortlisting and selecting candidates for studentship

When shortlisting the applications, priority will be given in the following order.

1. Income and no. of dependents
2. Status of father/mother
3. Special reason (Question 12 in the application form)
4. Future plan (Question 13 in the application form)

Further to the above criteria, it was decided to adopt existing selection criteria for vice chancellor's welfare fund, University of Jaffna, which includes the following.

1. Students who have lost their bread winners
2. Students who are from families with meager income and more children
3. Students who got married and with child/ children
4. Any other special cases
